SUBJECT: ISUZU MOTORS AMERICA, LLC POWERTRAIN DIVISION (ISZAPT) PRODUCT SUPPLY STATUS

As a result of the earthquake, tsunami, and devastation that followed March 11, 2011, Isuzu Motors Limited production of off-highway industrial diesel engines had halted until further analysis could be conducted. On April 4, 2011, ISZAPT reported factory production would resume April 5, 2011. This release is to provide updated and most current status as relates to production and product supply.

At this time, all production operations have returned to normal running 70 – 80% of full capacity. It is expected Isuzu will continue to ramp up the capacity as the supply chain restrictions are reduced and ultimately eliminated. At this time ISZAPT is continuing to prioritize sold orders with immediate delivery requirements first followed by stock orders. Individually, the ISZAPT SCM Department will continue to provide updates on revised shipment dates as the information becomes available.

Isuzu Motors Limited continues to demonstrate strong resilience and we are proud of their recovery efforts. Isuzu's recovery plans are swiftly returning to normal business levels. While numerous challenges remain (supply chain and electrical blackouts being the biggest threats) Isuzu is pleased to be providing products to the North American marketplace.

We thank you for your continued support, understanding, and patience as these recovery plans continue to progress and take shape. We will continue to communicate updates to you as they become available.
