3/14/2011**TO: ALL CUSTOMERS & PRESS****SUBJECT: PRODUCT SUPPLY STATUS: EARTHQUAKE & TSUNAMI IN JAPAN**

On Friday March 11, at 14:46 (2:46) Japan experienced an earthquake and subsequent tsunami resulting in loss of life and widespread damage.

The most significant damage occurred in the Tohoku area, the Northern part of the main island, with lesser yet significant damage in the Kanto area (the area including Tokyo). More than 4,200 persons are missing or deceased and many areas have not yet been searched. Electrical power shortages will occur in the areas of Tohoku and Kanto and major transport routes will be managed for emergency use only for an indefinite period of time.

Isuzu stopped production at its factories immediately following the disaster and has decided to resume all shipments after March 18, 2011 due largely to available electricity and transportation & logistics-related issues.

Isuzu is continuing to make contact with its supply and customer base and is planning accordingly. We intend to provide definitive updates for supply schedules in the next few days.
